**LAKE GEORGE LAND CONSERVANCY TO HOST STUDENTS FOR MAPLE SUGARING ADVENTURE**

(BOLTON LANDING) – The Lake George Land Conservancy will host its second season of maple sugaring field trips from March 23-26, at its Cook Mountain Preserve in Ticonderoga. Students will learn about the importance of trees as well as their uses and parts, cultural and natural history of the region, and the process of maple sugaring. The day will end with a tasting of sugar-on-snow. All activities are hands-on and will actively engage students.

Those attending include: a sixth grade class from Ticonderoga Middle School on March 23, from 1-2 p.m.; preschoolers from Ticonderoga Head Start on March 24 and 25, from 11 a.m. to noon; and a preschool class from Silver Bay Childcare Center on March 26, from 11 a.m. to noon.
